

Union Church of South Bristol - Board Meeting Minutes - August 21, 2016

Members Present: Linda Brunner, Beth Hood, Jack Hood, Connie Kennedy, Randall Waltz, Lori Wright and Norman Wright.

Linda brought the meeting to order.

Minutes from the previous meeting and treasurer's report had previously been distributed via email. With a motion by Connie Kennedy and seconded by Linda Brunner, the minutes from the June 19, 2016 meeting were approved.

The treasurer's report was accepted with a motion by Connie Kennedy and seconded by Norman Wright.

Norman spoke with Allen MacPhee – the new furnaces are on the schedule.

A special coffee hour has been scheduled for Don and Carolyn. Viola has a painting, which Linda will pick up. Connie will contact Sunday School families.

The parsonage has a sewery smell when doing laundry and showers. Ridex might do the trick. Lori will contact Mary O'Brien and if it doesn't work, she'll let us know.

Linda received a notice form the post office regarding the legal description and will take care of after the meeting.

Jack has been checking maintenance items on Sunday mornings. We will review maintenance plan next month.

Randall will get estimates from local paving companies for estimates on the post office parking lot. If we arrange now, we can get on their schedules for next summer. Randall could cold patch areas that might need fixing until the work is done.

Beth will find out more about planning a tree for the space where the Hawthorne tree was.

Norman has ordered new parts for the microphone system in the church, which have not arrived yet.

Karen has asked about the purchase of 4 extra white tables for the parish hall. Norman volunteered to pick them up at Sam's Club.

The post office was without water. Norman found the faucet in the men's room had been left on, causing the well to go dry. The faucet was broken, and Pendleton's came and fixed the problem.
